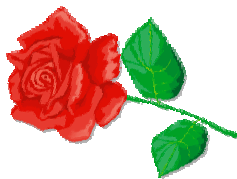

I love thee with a passion put to use

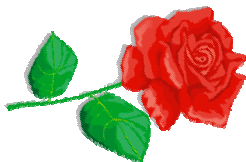
In my old griefs, and with my childhood's faith.
